DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE	<p style="text-align: center;">PROJECT SPECIFICATION</p> <p>Acquisition of consumables, chemicals and standards for the spectroquant test methods on an as and when required basis for a period of twelve (12) months from prospective service providers to the Department: Utilities Management Services: Water & Sanitation – Scientific & Quality Control Services.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1. BACKGROUND</p> <p>Drinking water and wastewater quality compliance monitoring legislation is enforcing more frequent water quality analyses to ensure that good water quality is supplied to the community as well as to comply with environmental legislations.</p> <p>Due to increased demand for water/wastewater quality analyses laboratory consumables and chemicals needs to be purchased on an as and when required basis.</p> <p>Quality assurance according to SANAS and ISO 17025 will be compulsory, verification of methods and chemicals, safety as well as SABS and accreditation specifications will be very important factors when evaluating this tender.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2. SCOPE OF WORK</p> <p>The spectroquant test methods includes amongst others Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD), Colour, Turbidity, Sulphate (SO₄²⁻), Sulphite (SO₃⁻), Fluoride (F⁻). Of all the mentioned analyses is Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD) the most important analyses in the spectroquant test methods range.</p> <p>The COD is a measure of wastewater and industrial quality. The COD tests is mostly used to monitor wastewater treatment plant efficiency. The COD is the amount of oxygen consumed to chemically oxidize organic water contaminants to inorganic end products.</p>

Chemical oxygen demand is a parameter that indicates the total chemically oxidisable material in the sample and therefore indicates the energy content of a feedstock. During this analysis the sample is refluxed in a boiling mixture of sulphuric acid and a known excess of potassium dichromate ($K_2Cr_2O_7$). The COD thus determines the amount of oxygen required for chemical oxidation of organic matter using a strong chemical oxidant, such as, potassium dichromate under reflux conditions.

For any quantitative analysis, regardless of the technique, the instrument response is largely meaningless without reference to a known value. For this reason, almost all analyses include a set of calibration reference samples (or standards) as well relevant consumables to ensure that the discrete photometric analyser is fully operational.

Quality assurance, verification, safety as well as SABS and accreditation specifications will be very important factors when evaluating this bid.
