3.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ If the director is using the house of someone, can they also sign the lease agreement as a house owner? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ If the director is operating their business from their house/premises, they need to sign a lease agreement between the bidder/business (as a juristic person) and the director (as a natural person). ✓ If the business is operated from a different place than the residential address of the director, the bidder/company must sign a lease agreement with the owner of the house/premises. ✓ If the director is using the house/premises of someone else they cannot sign the lease agreement as the owner as they are not the owner of the house/premises. However, they must sign a lease agreement with the owner of the house/premises
