

EULOGY BY THE EXECUTIVE MAYOR OF MOGALE CITY LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, CLLR DANNY THUPANE AT THE FUNERAL OF PASTOR LERATO EMILY LEMEKE HELD ON 27 APRIL 2023 AT THE FAITH COMMUNITY SANCTUARY, KAGISO, MOGALE CITY
