The Government of Local Unity is privileged to have been invited to this activity that raises awareness about the safety of food in our province. We are particularly pleased to have you here, MEC, as the country reacts to the news that no less than fourteen lives have been lost to cholera just recently.

The fact that a person has to use their last hard-earned money to purchase a product that has the potential to condemn them to a hospital bed or, at worst, to the fate of death is more than saddening. It is annoying and evokes the worst in us.



We are therefore fully geared to tackle this scourge with you. We agree that it has to be uprooted and should not end here. We need to kill it from the source, so that our lives are not compromised. We have to find and close the suppliers, lock them up and throw away the key. By starving the suppliers then we can go a long way in securing citizens from these heartless operators.

MEC, it is mostly little children who get targeted by these unscrupulous operators. We all know that fake sweets, beverages, and other supposed-to-be niceties are sold to little children, and we have read and heard many sad stories about it. Some these operators were bold enough to target children at schools and as a result some children have died from it. How cruel can a person be? How disrespectful can these people be?
